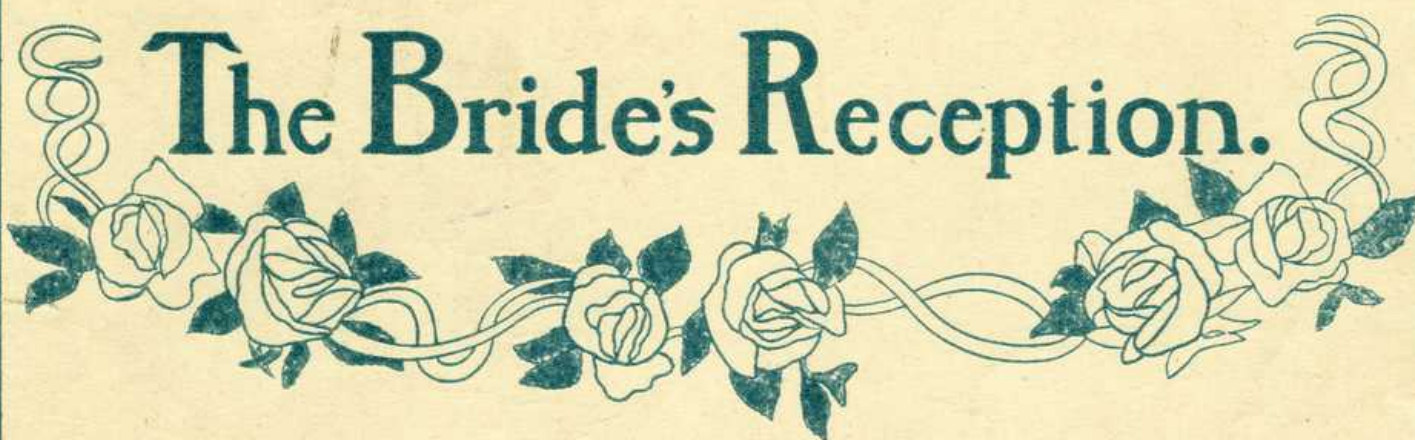

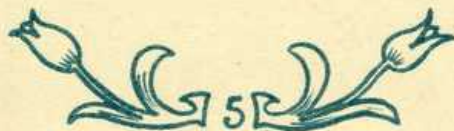

INTRO.
