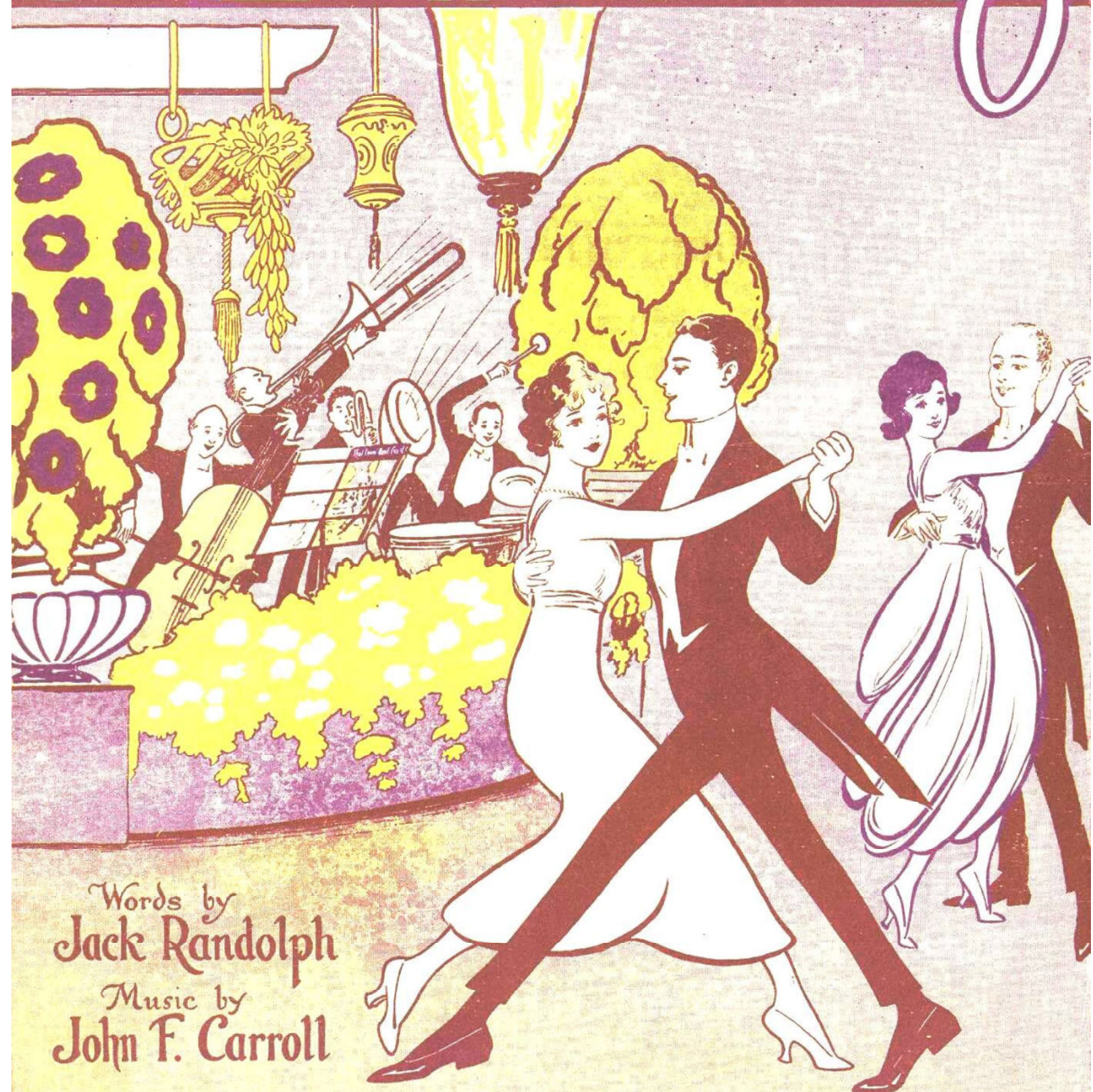


That Lovin' Roof Garden Rag
