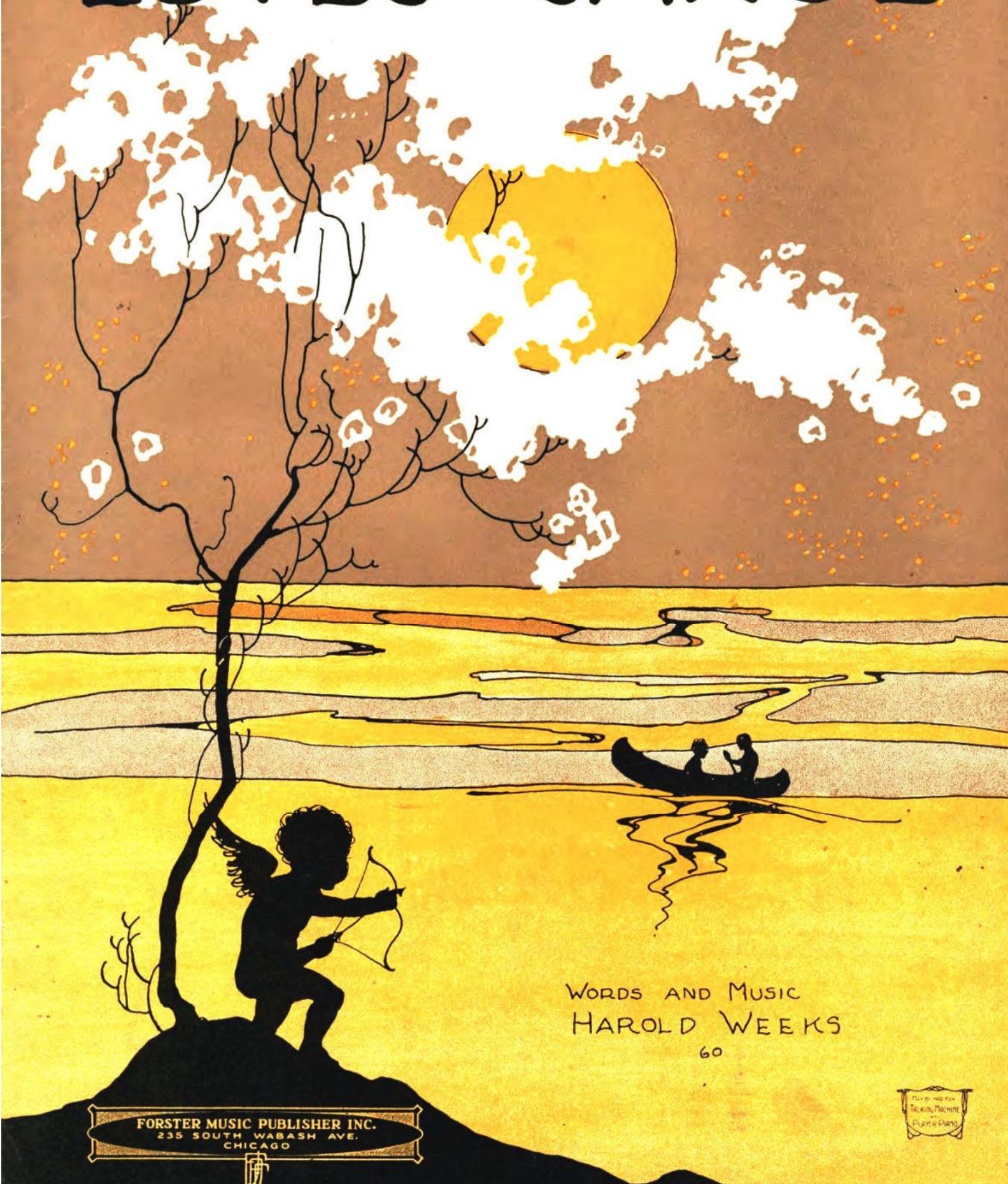

Waltztime
