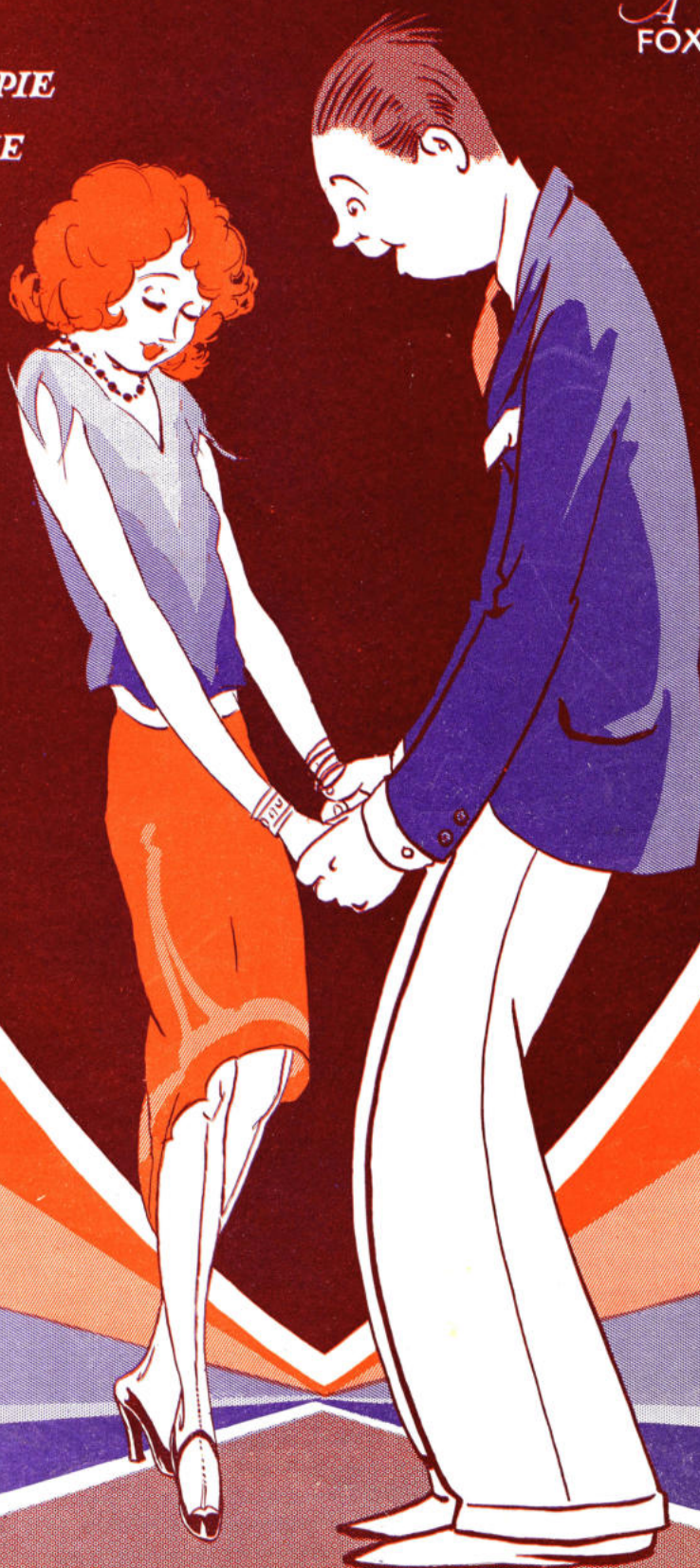

Moderato
