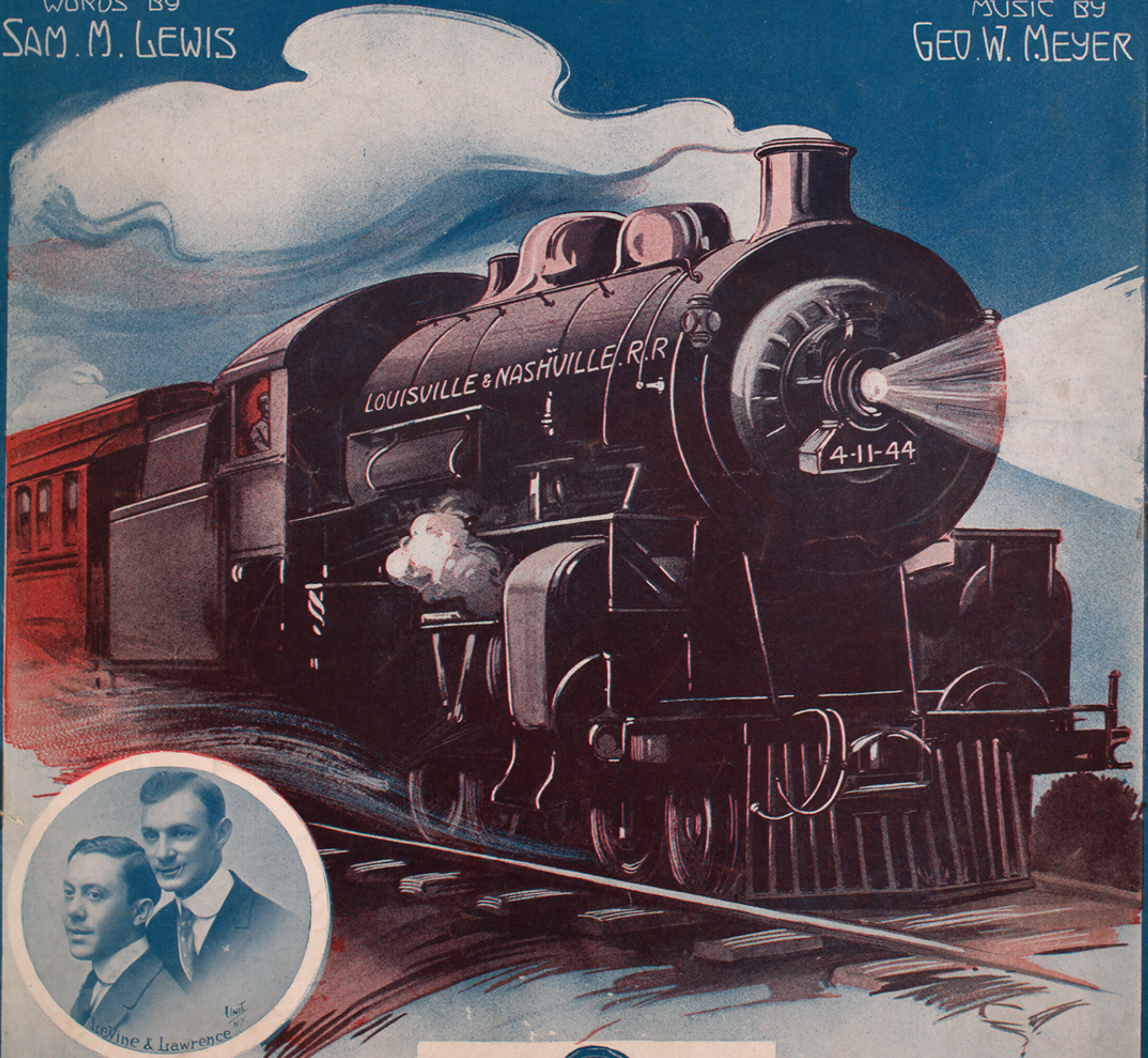

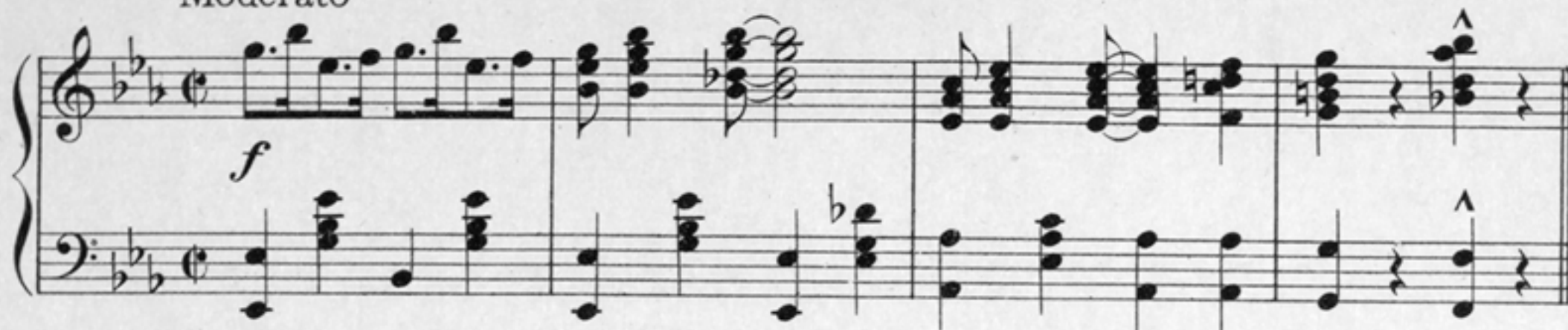


Make That Engine Stop At Louisville
