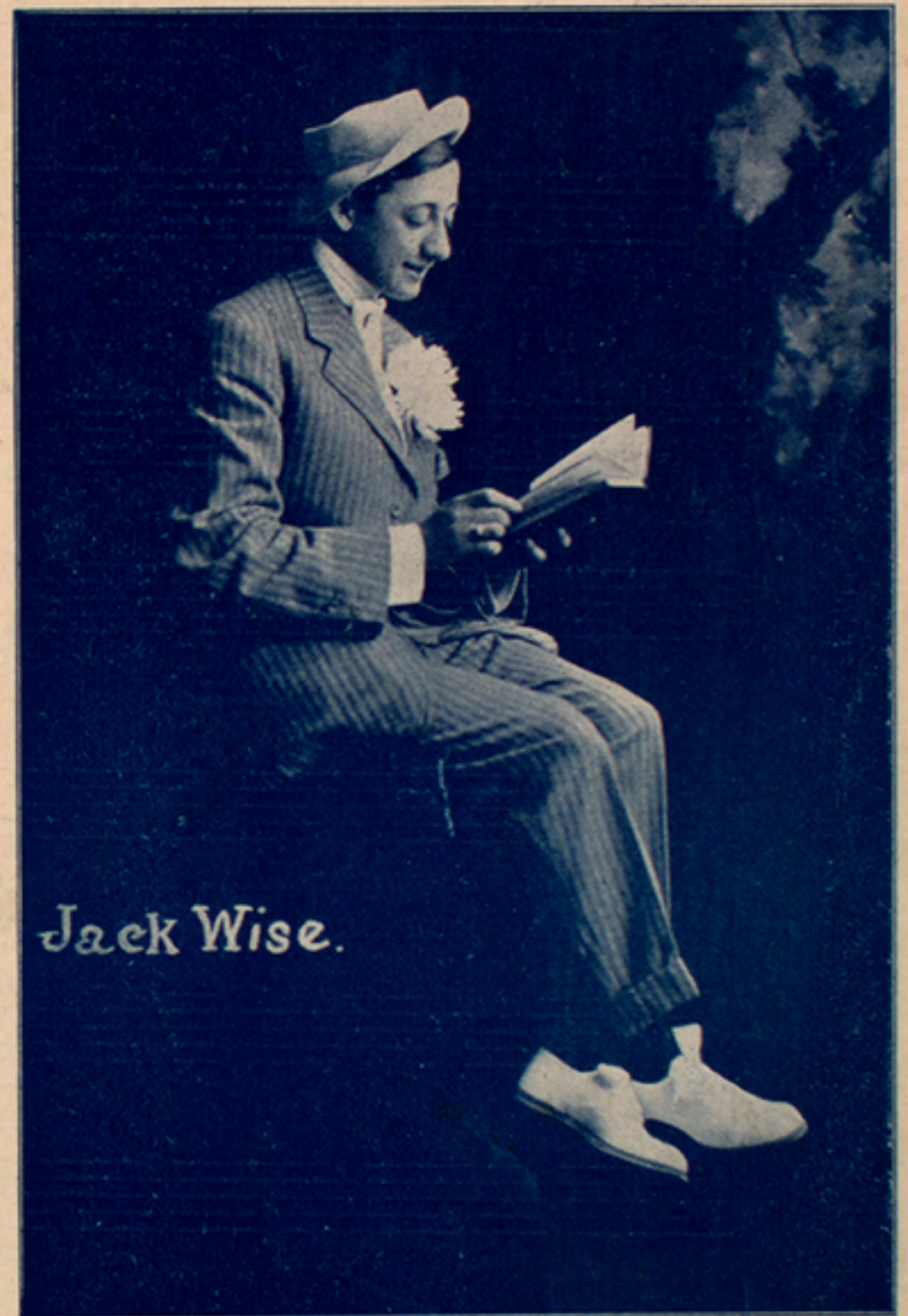

Andante.

The piano introduction is in 2/4 time, key of B-flat major. It begins with a piano (*p*) dynamic.
