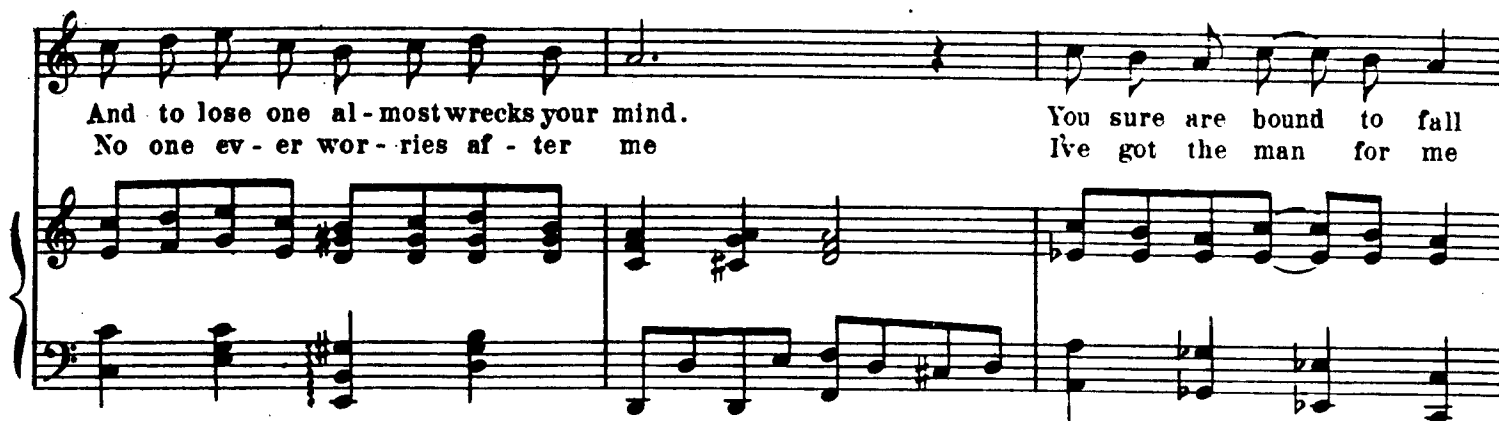
Vamp slow
