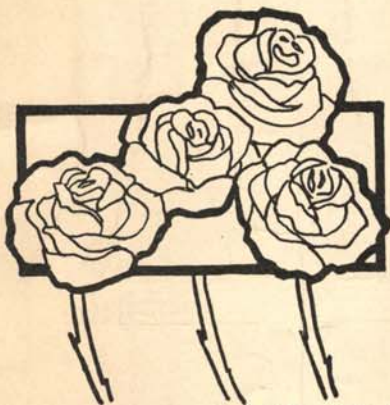

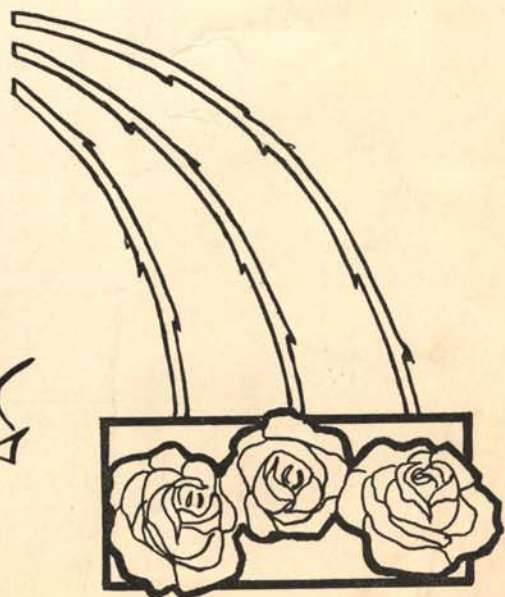

Tempo di Marcia
